### ASSESSMENT:

The grade for this course will be based on ten lab report/writeups. These reports are to be prepared following the instructions and outline for each of the labs given in the lab manual. The lab reports are graded for student participation in the lab, completeness of the report (i.e. answer all questions, draw and label all graphs, include appropriate purpose and conclusion) and correctness of lab report content. Labs are due two weeks after they are conducted in class. Points will be deducted for late lab reports.
